BEFORE THE STUDY

- ▶ Find a study online at: iSupportResearch.com/find-a-study
- ▶ Patient eligibility is verified via phone interview.
- ▶ Qualified patients are invited to visit a clinic in-person.

THE SCREENING PROCESS

- ▶ Patients read, review and sign an informed Consent Form (ICF).
- ▶ Trained medical professionals take initial physical health stats and ask questions related to the study.
- ▶ On average, 20-100 participants (healthy participants and/or participants with medical conditions) are selected to participate.

DURING THE STUDY

- ▶ Doctors and nurses administer study medication(s) to participants.
- ▶ Trained medical professionals monitor participants for physical changes or side effects.
- ▶ Medical professionals determine how study medication is metabolized.

AFTER THE STUDY

- ▶ Participants' final physical stats are taken.
- ▶ An extra questionnaire is offered to all participants to complete.
- ▶ Participants stipend (as determined by trial sponsor).

Benefits

- Personal contributions to helping advance medicine.
- Participation may increase knowledge about conditions that affect you and those you love.
- In-patients*: meals, internet, media center, opportunity to meet and socialize with fellow participants.

Responsibilities

- Ability to travel to and from clinic.
- In-patients*: Ability to commit to a duration of several days - several weeks in clinic.
- Out-patient*: Ability to participate in scheduled appointments throughout the duration of the study.
